GOLDEN SCORE

Golden score From M/F1 to M/F6: no time limit. From M/F7 and above 1 minute maximum. If there is a tie at the end of the Golden score, the central referee in consultation with the table referees, will agree on a final decision to select the winner.

COMPETITION SYSTEM

For 2 athletes in a best of three bouts weight. - There will be 3, 4 and 5 athletes league.

- 6 sportsmen there will be two leagues with semi-final and final - 7 or more sportsmen direct elimination with double repechage.

WIGHTS

Male weights: -60, -66, -73, -81, -90, -100 and +100 Kg.

Female weights: -48, -52, -57, -63, -70, -78 and + 78 Kg.

Number of Tatamis: 3

COMBINATION OF AGES AND WEIGHTS

In case of lack of participants in any weight category, they may participate by lowering or raising one or two age categories.

or two age categories. In the following order for the combination of ages and weights.

1.- To move down one or two age categories.

2.- Move up one or two age categories.

3.- To move up one or two weight categories in the same age category.

4.- To move up one or two weight categories by dropping one or two age categories.

In the age categories for people over 60 years of age (from M7 and F7 onwards) only one age category Will be allowed to go up or down.

AWARDING OF MEDALS

Medals will be awarded at the end of the competition. All competitors who have obtained a medal. They must attend the medal ceremony to receive their medal in white judogi, and black or brown belt if applicable.

1 athlete: no medal is awarded.

2 athletes: two medals awarded.

3 sportsmen and women: three medals awarded.

4 sportsmen/women: four medals awarded.

5 sportsmen/women: four medals awarded.

6 or more sportsmen/women: four medals awarded.



If a category has been combined, in order to make possible the participation of the participants, the only medals awarded will be to the competitors in that combined category.

If a competitor does not appear at the award ceremony to receive his medal without a justified reason, the medal will not be awarded at a later date.

DOCUMENTS

- * Certificate of being in possession of the national licence for the 2025 season.
- * D.N.I. or passport (to be presented at the time of weigh-in).
- * Proof of payment of the registration fee.
- * Minimum brown belt.
- * Athletes born in 1985 or previous years must provide a medical certificate of fitness for judo competition, which must be presented to their regional federation, which in turn will send its Vº Bº together with the registration for the competition. However, the competitors must take the certificate with them to the championship in case there is a need for verification.

The official medical certificate of "sport aptitude" must be issued by a registered professional and will state that the athlete is fit to practice and participate in judo competitions.

- * It will be essential that they are in possession of a minimum of three consecutive licences or five alternate licences, one of them being that of the current year.
